ARTICLES

Article 3: Shall the District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant, or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein totaling Nine Million Nine Hundred Fifty Four Thousand, Nine Hundred and Sixty Five dollars (\$9,954,965) ? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be Nine Million, Nine Hundred Thousand, Eight Hundred and Forty dollars (\$9,900,840), which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only.

Article 4: Shall the District approve the cost items included in the collective bargaining agreement reached between the Sunapee School Board and the Sunapee Teachers Association, which calls for the following increases and benefits totaling:

Year	Estimated Increase
2010-11	\$ 99,480.00
2011-12	\$106,143.00
2012-13	\$109,482.00

And further raise and appropriate the sum of Ninety Nine Thousand, Four Hundred Eighty dollars (\$99,480) for the 2010-2011 fiscal year, such sum represents the additional costs attributable to the increase in salaries and benefits contained within the bargaining agreement. The costs for the years of the agreement beyond the upcoming 2010-2011 fiscal year will be included in the operating budget proposal each of those years.
