

SUNAPEE TRANSFER STATION FACTS

DID YOU KNOW:

- THE PROPOSED TRANSFER STATION OPERATING BUDGET FOR 2016 IS \$499,462? THIS IS \$6,518 LESS THAN THE 2015 DEFAULT BUDGET, AND IS A DECREASE OF 1.3%. THE TRANSFER STATION MAKES UP 9.49% OF THE TOWN'S TOTAL OPERATING BUDGET.
- THE TOWN OF SPRINGFIELD IS RESPONSIBLE FOR FUNDING 25% OF THE TOWN'S PROPOSED TRANSFER STATION OPERATING BUDGET?
- THE TRANSFER STATION ACCEPTS WASTE OIL, AND THEN RECYCLES THE WASTE OIL IN IT'S OWN WASTE OIL FIRED FURNACE, WHICH PROVIDES HEAT FOR THE LARGE STORAGE BUILDING (WHERE CARDBOARD IS DISPOSED OF)?
- IN 2016, WE ARE CONSIDERING IMPROVEMENTS THAT WILL MAKE YOUR VISIT AT THE TRANSFER STATION MORE EFFICIENT? ONE IMPROVEMENT BEING CONSIDERED INCLUDES DEVELOPING A SECOND EXIT THAT WILL BE CONSTRUCTED BEFORE THE EXISTING LEAF DISPOSAL AREA. THE INTENT IS TO KEEP RESIDENTS FROM HAVING TO TURN AROUND AND COME BACK AGAINST TRAFFIC TO EXIT THE TRANSFER STATION AFTER DISPOSING OF C&D, METALS, OR LEAVES.
- ONLY TRANSFER STATION VENDORS AND/OR EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWN OF SUNAPEE ARE PERMITTED TO BE OUT BEHIND THE HAPPY SHACK, OR IN THE STORAGE BUILDING? FOR YOUR SAFETY, PLEASE DO NOT TRAVEL AND/OR WALK IN AREAS THAT ARE NOT SPECIFICALLY DESIGNATED FOR DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTE COMMODITIES AT THE TRANSFER STATION.
- ALL SOLID WASTE THAT IS BROUGHT TO THE TRANSFER STATION IS SUBJECT TO INSPECTION BY ONE OF THE TOWN'S TRANSFER STATION ATTENDANTS? OUR INTENT IS TO MAKE SURE THAT TRANSFER STATION USERS ARE DISPOSING OF SOLID WASTE ITEMS IN ACCORDANCE WITH OUR NHDES SOLID WASTE PERMIT.
