Board of Commissioners Meeting
May 26, 2016
Sunapee Town Offices

PRESENT: Theodore Gallup-Chairman, Peter Hill, J. Anthony Bergeron, Jimmy Williams, Kurt Markarian, Paul Manson.

Also present: Holly Leonard, David Bailey.

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 5:33 p.m.

1. Forms for Signing:

April 28, 2016 Meeting Minutes: Anthony B. made a motion to accept the minutes as printed, seconded by Jimmy W., voted unanimously in favor, so declared by the Chairman.

April Sewer Purchase Journal: Anthony B. made a motion to accept the Journal as printed, seconded by Kurt M., after some discussion regarding J.F. McDermott and the sewer jetting machine, voted unanimously in favor, so declared by the Chairman.

April Water Purchase Journal: Peter H. made a motion to accept the Water Purchase Journal as written, seconded by Anthony B., voted unanimously in favor, so declared by the Chairman.

NOR 107 Abatement Request: Anthony B. made a motion to accept the request for abatement from Jack & Buster Investments, seconded by Peter H., voted unanimously in the affirmative, so declared by the Chairman.

ORR 66 Abatement Request: Anthony B. made a motion to accept the request for abatement from GG Polley, seconded by Kurt M., voted unanimously in favor, so declared by the Chairman.

2. Wastewater Treatment Highlights: Dave B. reported that the plant is running pretty well and that New London has been pumping out their lagoons and sending the liquid to the plant. Dave B. stated that he has not noticed any issues arising from this happening and that DES employees have been doing some testing with fatty acids that attract bugs that will remove phosphorus biologically. Dave B. reported that the department is raising manholes like crazy on Jobs Creek, Woodland Road and Garnet Hill for paving. There was some discussion regarding the use of riser rings so that manhole covers can be lowered in the winter for plowing, and if the department is using plastic or riser rings or metal ones. Dave B. stated that they had done a sewer hook-up on Garnet Hill for Clarks Construction prior to the paving. There was some discussion regarding how much water New London was sending from the lagoons, septic receiving and the sign at the end of Treatment Plant Road.

3. Water Treatment Highlights:

Dave B. stated that hydrant flushing had happened at the end of last month and that there had been some complaints about rusty water on Central Street for a couple of weeks after

that had happened and that he does not know why that would be. Dave B. passed around a letter from Underwood recommending that Sunapee use Sodium Silicate for corrosion control.


4. Old & New Business: Dave B. reported that the old Treatment Plant Generator had gone to Unity

The next meeting will be held June 30th.


5:55 p.m. Paul M. made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Peter H., voted unanimously in the affirmative, so declared by the Chairman.




